What is HOPE61 - Based on *Isaiah 61:1*, **HOPE61** trains and equips churches worldwide to understand the issue of human trafficking, identify the causes of vulnerability of local people to become involved in human trafficking and discover the gifts, talents, abilities and resources that God has given each church to reduce the vulnerability of those around them. At its core, HOPE61 is an evangelism and discipleship catalyst aimed at people who are vulnerable to become involved in human trafficking.

HOPE61 seeks to prevent the spread of, and ultimately, the end of human trafficking and slavery in our world today. HOPE61 is biblically based, bringing the message of eternal salvation to those that are vulnerable to become involved in human trafficking across the world.

It is centered on church involvement in raising awareness, identifying those easily targeted for human trafficking within their own respective communities and caring for those identified. The primary focus is prevention through empowering those likely to fall victim to human trafficking whether it be as a victim, seller or buyer. WHY April 16-18:

At September's EMC General Council meeting it was decided to offer the HOPE61 Multiply Training the 3 days prior to April's General Conference to take advantage of several already traveling to the Indianapolis conference, both internationally and within the USA. We realize this will require a longer commitment to be in Indianapolis if you attend General Conference. However, it was decided the travel expenses negated the longer period of time away from home, church and/or work. We appreciate those choosing to make this commitment to bringing the *HOPE61 Ministry* into the EMC churches.

WHO should attend:

1. Prayerfully consider this ministry and your desire to learn more about HOPE61
2. Interested churches are encouraged to send 2 or more people for HOPE61 training.
3. Training is for both MEN and WOMEN
4. Participants must be 18 years of age or older

COSTS:

\$130 WITH Lodging

HOUSING Details:

OMS Campus - Those attending the HOPE61 Training may stay on the OMS campus Sunday evening, April 15, through Thursday morning, April 19th, for \$80 per person. Two people may be assigned per bedroom with a common living area which includes a refrigerator and a microwave.

OMS is located at 941 Fry Road, Greenwood, Indiana (approximately 4 miles from EMCHQ)
Transportation, upon request, provided to & from the workshop

Accommodations:

Private bedrooms with shared kitchen and living areas

Some units have private bathrooms; 2 to 4 people per unit.

Any husband and wife teams registered can share a room.
